ADOPTED JUNE 15, 2005

**A RESOLUTION SETTING THE COSTS AND FEES
CHARGED FOR CEMETERY LOTS AND SERVICES**

WHEREAS, 12.20.050 of the Wellsville Municipal Code provides that the costs and fees charged for cemetery lots and services may be adjusted from time to time by the governing body by means of a resolution; and

WHEREAS, the current cost and fee schedule was adopted by Resolution 88-05 on April 13, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the governing body has determined there is a need to increase the costs and fees associated with the cemetery;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Wellsville City, Cache County, State of Utah that the following costs and fee schedule is hereby adopted:

RESIDENT

Full Lot (8 burial spaces)	\$ 400.00		+ \$ 400.00	=	\$ 800.00
1/8 Lot (1 burial space)	\$ 50.00		+ \$ 50.00	=	\$ 100.00

Opening and Closing:

Full size	\$ 200.00 plus \$ 100.00 for Holidays & Saturdays
Infant size	\$ 100.00 plus \$ 100.00 for Holidays & Saturdays
Cemetery deed transfer	\$ 50.00 per deed issued

Resident is defined as: For the purchase of a lot as a resident, the person must be either a property tax taxpayer and/or a register voter of Wellsville at the time of purchase. To be buried as a resident, the person must be either a property tax taxpayer and/or a register voter of Wellsville at the time of death. The only exception to the above is if the person is in a rest home or cared for by family (outside Wellsville City) at the time of the transaction

Full size	\$ 400.00 plus \$ 100.00 for Holidays & Saturdays
Infant size	\$ 200.00 plus \$ 100.00 for Holidays & Saturdays
Cemetery deed transfer	\$ 50.00 per deed issued
