### SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFICIARIES ONE TIME ECONOMIC RECOVERY PAYMENT

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act provides a one-time economic recovery payment of \$250.00 to people who receive Social Security, Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Railroad Retirement, or Veterans benefits. If you were eligible for the any of the above benefits anytime during the months of Nov. 2008, Dec. 2008 or January 2009, you are eligible for the recovery payment.

You should receive your one-time payment by the end of May 2009. **THERE IS NO ACTION REQUIRED ON YOUR PART.** If you do not receive your payment by June 4, 2009 you need to contact the Social Security Office.

Do not ever disclose personal information if someone e-mails you regarding the one-time recovery payment and asks for personal information.
