RESOLUTION NUMBER 2009-07

ADOPTED 12-02-2009

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wellsville, Cache County, State of Utah, as authorized by law, Section 10-8-84 Utah Code Annotated, is authorized to prescribe Rules and Regulations which are not inconsistent with law and as it deems best for the efficient administration, organization, operation, conduct and business of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined that it would be in the best interest of the City of Wellsville to adopt policies and procedures providing for rules and regulations for governing City parks, playgrounds, recreational facilities and other City owned facilities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Sections 10-8-84 and 10-3 Part 7 of the Utah State Code, Annotated, 1953, as amended, and all other applicable laws and regulations, and in the best interests of the City and its residents, the City Council of the City of Wellsville, Cache County, State of Utah, hereby adopts, passes and posts the following:

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
RULES AND REGULATIONS
GOVERNING CITY PARKS,
PLAYGROUNDS, RECREATIONAL
FACILITIES AND OTHER CITY
OWNED FACILITIES**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSVILLE, CACHE COUNTY, STATE OF UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

Penalties for Violations.

- A. Any person found to be in violation of this Wellsville City Resolution may be evicted immediately from the public park, playground or recreational facility by an Officer of the Cache County Sheriff's Office or the Utah Highway Patrol.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to remain in and/or return to any public park, playground or recreational facility after such person has been given direction to leave such public park, playground or recreational facility.
- C. The violation of any of provision of this Title shall constitute a Class C Misdemeanor.

Wellsville Reservoir Fishing.

Fishing shall be permitted in the Wellsville Reservoir in accordance with rules and regulations established by the Utah Department of Wildlife Resources. Under no circumstance shall the cleaning of fish be allowed in any park, playground or recreation Facility.

Wellsville Reservoir Boating.

No motorized boats or motorized floating conveyances of any kind shall be allowed on the Wellsville Reservoir.

Night Closure.

All Wellsville City parks, playgrounds and recreation Facilities shall be closed between the hours of dark and one hour prior to dawn.

Temporary Closure.

The Wellsville City Manager or his designee shall have the authority to temporarily close and/or restrict access to any park, playground, or recreation Facility any portion thereof when such closure and/or restriction is determined by the Mayor or designee to be necessary for: (1) the reasonable and proper protection of the park, playground or recreation facility; (2) the reasonable and proper protection of City residents or any other potential user from any existing or potential hazard; and/or (3) any other emergency circumstance or situation which may arise.

Special Events.

Special events shall be defined as an activity at any park, playground or recreation facility involving a group of more than fifty people. Prior to holding a special event, the event sponsor must coordinate with the Wellsville City Manager or designee. Examples of activities considered to be a special event include; family reunions, church group dinners, and scouting activities.

Public Elimination.

It shall be unlawful for any person to expectorate, urinate or defecate at any public park, playground or other recreational facility, except into a toilet provided for that purpose.

Use of Restroom Facilities and Drinking Fountains.

- A. No person over six (6) years of age shall enter into or use any toilet facility designated for members of the opposite sex at any park, playground or other recreational facility.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to put any object in any sinks, toilets or drinking fountains, which is not normally used in those receptacles, which is reasonably likely to clog or plug the plumbing.

Restrictions on Animals.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any dog to enter or remain in a park, playground or recreational facility unless it is contained on a leash.
- B. Any owner or person having control of a dog must properly dispose in a waste receptacle or other designated place, any waste left by such dog in the public park, playground or recreational facility.
