**ATTENTION ALL RESIDENTS ON CENTER STREET**

Garbage will be collected on **Monday, July 31<sup>st</sup> instead of Tuesday, August 1<sup>st</sup>** for all residents living on Center Street in Wellsville. Please have your container(s) out for collection by **7:00 a.m. on Monday, July 31<sup>st</sup>**. Tour of Utah will be riding on Center Street the morning of **Tuesday, August 1<sup>st</sup>**. As a safety precaution, please do not leave your garbage container(s) on the road after they have been emptied. This change in service is only for residents on Center Street and will only change collection for the dates shown above. Thank you for your cooperation!
