WINTER PARKING

It's that time of the year where NO PARKING is allowed on any city street between the hours of midnight and 8:00 a.m. All vehicles, boats, campers, trailers, construction equipment, etc. must be removed from the city right-of-ways. Citations will be issued for those who are not in compliance. The winter parking regulations take effect from November 1, 2017 to April 30, 2018.

HOME FIRE PREVENTION TIPS

The Wellsville Fire Department would like residents of Wellsville to be aware of the following:

More than 3,400 Americans die each year in fires and approximately 17,500 are injured. An overwhelming number of fires occur in the home. There are time-tested ways to prevent and survive a fire. It's not a question of luck. It's a matter of planning ahead.

► **EVERY HOME SHOULD HAVE AT LEAST ONE WORKING SMOKE ALARM ON EACH LEVEL:** Test it monthly, keep it free of dust and replace the battery at least once a year. Don't forget to replace the batteries in CO detectors also.

► **PREVENT ELECTRICAL FIRES:** Never overload circuits or extension cords. Do not place cords and wires under rugs, over nails, under furniture, in doorways, or in high-traffic areas.

► **FURNANCE MAINTENANCE:** Now is the time to have your furnace serviced. Be sure to keep all combustible materials away from your furnace.

► **KEEP FIRE IN THE FIREPLACE:** Use fire screens and have your chimneys cleaned annually. The creosote buildup can ignite a chimney fire that could spread. NOW is the time to have your chimney cleaned.

► **USE APPLIANCES WISELY:** When using appliances follow the manufacturer's safety precautions. Overheating, unusual smells, shorts and sparks are all warning signs that appliances need to be shut off, then replaced or repaired. Make sure each time you use the clothes dryer that the vents are clean of lint buildup.

By taking the time to check these items, you could save your home from being visited by the fire department. Plan to be safe!

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT THE USE OF SUMP PUMPS DRAINING INTO THE SEWER SYSTEM OR FLOOR DRAINS FROM YOUR HOME IS AGAINST CITY CODE 8-3-10A AND IS NOT ALLOWED. PLEASE DO YOUR PART BY DISCHARGING STORM WATER FROM YOUR HOME INTO A STORM WATER DRAIN WHICH WOULD INCLUDE AN OUTSIDE SWELL, DITCH OR CURB AND GUTTER. WELLSVILLE CITY IS CURRENTLY LOOKING AT ENFORCEMENT OPTIONS.

CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Tree recycling will be available from December 15, 2017 thru January 11, 2018. The recycling drop off site is located behind the fire station (approximately 65 East Main). Please make sure the Christmas trees that you recycle are free of tinsel, ornaments, lights and metal stands.
