

MINUTES of a special City Council meeting of Wellsville City held Thursday, June 13, 2013, at the Wellsville Elementary School at 80 East 100 South in Wellsville. City officials present were Mayor Thomas G. Bailey, Councilwoman Glenna Petersen, Councilmen Gary Bates, Ron Case, Colin Harrison, and Carl Leatham. City Manager/Recorder Don Hartle was also present.
