### WELLSVILLE CITY PARK RULES

#### For the Wellsville Dam Area

"Please be respectful of our Beautiful Parks"

#### **PARK IS CLOSED AFTER DARK**

1. No smoking, alcoholic beverages, or drugs allowed
2. No overnight camping except in designated camping areas on the east side of the dam
3. Fires only in fire rings
4. Dogs on a leash at all times-owners are responsible for waste cleanup
5. No horses or motorized vehicles on grass or trails
6. No littering or dumping-garbage receptacles available for use
7. No discharge of firearms, explosives or fireworks
8. No loud music, boisterous or threatening conduct, indecent language or any other disruptive behavior
9. A valid fishing license is required.
11. No swimming or motorized boats or watercraft in the reservoir
12. No archery, golf, or paint balling
13. No actions deemed destructive to park, restroom, recreational facilities or surrounding property
