### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

#### REGARDING UPCOMING CENSUS SURVEYS

CENSUS SURVEYS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO WELLSVILLE CITY RESIDENTS AROUND THE MIDDLE OF MARCH. IT IS A MUST THAT THEY BE COMPLETED BY ALL RESIDENTS. THE INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM THE CENSUS SURVEYS ARE USED TO DETERMINE THE AMOUNT OF TAX REVENUE THE CITY WILL RECEIVE. MOST OF THE TAX REVENUES THE CITY RECEIVES IS BASED ON POPULATION INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM THIS CENSUS. THEREFORE, IF RESIDENTS FAIL TO COMPLETE THEIR CENSUS SURVEYS, THE CITY WILL LOSE TAX REVENUE. YOUR COOPERATION IS GREATLY APPRECIATED IN THIS IMPORTANT MATTER!

#### 2010 DOG LICENSING

All dogs are required to be licensed, whether they are indoor or outdoor pets. License fees are \$5 for dogs that are spayed/neutered, or \$10 for dogs that are unaltered. You must provide a spaying/neutering certificate to purchase the \$5 license. Proof of a current rabies shot, valid for the entire year of 2010, must also be provided. **AFTER MARCH 31<sup>ST</sup>, 2010 THE FEES FOR DOG TAGS TRIPLE.** If you own three or more dogs, please contact the City Office to get approval for a kennel license.

#### KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Mountainside Elementary Kindergarten registration will be held on Monday, March 1; Tuesday, March 2; and Thursday, March 4, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. in the school office. When registering you will need to bring your child, your child's birth certificate and his/her immunization record.
