#### MEMORIAL DAY PROGRAM

#### EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

In the event of a disaster, there's a new radio station in Cache County that can provide residents with important emergency information. WQKP, 1610 AM, was established with funds from a 2008 Federal Homeland Security grant to broadcast emergency public information in a disaster. Cache County is currently broadcasting National Weather Service information on this Station, but future programming will also include educational emergency preparedness information. Broadcasts will be made from this channel to keep residents updated around the clock during emergencies.
