BUSINESS LICENSES

As a reminder to those residents who may have a home occupation, it is time to renew your business license for 2012. If you have received a renewal form, please return the form to the city office ASAP. If you are currently engaged in a business here in Wellsville, but are not licensed, please contact the City Office to apply for a business license. It is a Class B Misdemeanor to operate a business without a business license.

EXTRA RECYCLING FOR THE HOLIDAYS

The Christmas season often brings extra boxes, wrapping paper, and other recyclable items. In order to help accommodate this extra recycling, the Logan City Environmental Department will provide an extra recycling collection day during the holiday season. On January 3rd and January 10th residents will have their recyclables collected both days. After that time, recycling will resume at an every-other-week collection schedule. TREE RECYCLING

Tree recycling is available from January 1, 2012 thru January 9th, 2012. The recycling drop off is located behind the fire station (approximately 65 East Main.) Please be sure your tree is free of lights, tinsel, and ornaments. If you should miss the window for drop off, the green waste facility located at the Logan Landfill is open year round.

SOCCER REGISTRATION



This year you can register online or in person for spring soccer. Online registration will open January 9th and close February 11th. 2012 DOG LICENSING

It's time to purchase dog tags for 2012. All dogs are required to be licensed, whether they are indoor or outdoor pets. License fees are \$5.00 for dogs that are spayed/neutered, or \$10.00 for dogs that are unaltered. (You must provide a spaying/neutering certificate to purchase the \$5.00 license.) All dog owners must provide proof of a current rabies vaccination for each dog. After **March 31, 2012** the fees for the dog tags will triple, so don't procrastinate. If you have three or more dogs, contact the City Office to get approved for a kennel license.

The city will be holding a rabies clinic next door to the City Office at 79 East Main. The rabies vaccination will cost \$15.00. One check may be issued for both the rabies shot and the dog license. Please make checks payable to "Wellsville City Corporation."

SNOW REMOVAL FROM SIDEWALKS

Please make note that it is the property owner's responsibility to clean snow off the sidewalks in front of their homes. Snow is not to be pushed across city streets. Fines can occur for those in violation. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

COMMERCIAL/BUSINESS STORM DRAIN SYSTEM PROTECTION

- Regularly clean/sweep parking lots to prevent debris run off into storm drain system.
- Inspect and clean storm drain inlets and catch basins of any debris or garbage.
- Where applicable, install oil/water separators, chemical separators, snouts, or other appropriate filtration devices.
- Limit the amount of pesticides and herbicides applied to lawn, park strips and landscaped areas.
- Verify that wash bay facilities are draining to sanitary sewer and not to storm drain.
- Cover loaded trucks to prevent items from blowing out and entering storm drain system.
- Snow removal-minimizing de-icing salts (alternate methods)
- Cover trash containers to prevent garbage migration via wind/animals to storm water system.
