LAST REMINDER FOR 2012 DOG LICENSING

All dogs are required to be licensed whether they are indoor or outdoor pets. License fees are \$5 for dogs that are spayed/neutered, or \$10 for dogs that are unaltered. You must provide a spayed/neutering certificate to purchase the \$5 license. Proof of current rabies shot, valid for the entire year of 2012, must also be provided. **AFTER MARCH 31ST 2012 THE FEES FOR DOG TAGS WILL TRIPLE.** If you own three or more dogs, please contact the city office to get approval for a kennel license.

WELLSVILLE CITY PRINCESS INFORMATION



STORMWATER

What is a storm drain? A storm drain is the grate openings in the street that collects water from rain and melting snow to minimize street flooding. Rainwater often carries street debris, trash, leaves, fertilizer, pesticides, grass clippings, pet waste, paints, anti-freeze, used motor oil and bare soils that end up in the storm drains when people dispose of them improperly.

Where does it go? Everything that we do outdoors has an effect on the water bodies around us. As water flows it collects difference pollutants that are left in its path. It then travels to the nearest storm drain where it is carried to the nearest lake, pond, river or stream. Let's make sure "Only rain goes down the drain!"

COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM

Wellsville City is joining with the Cache County Sheriff's Office and the Cache County Response Team (CERT) Council to offer an 8-week course for people interested in leaning how to take care of themselves, their families, and their communities in an emergency.

Wellsville City will reimburse city residents who successfully complete this course (requires attending all 8 classes and the simulated emergency).
