#### BURN PERMITS

The spring open burning season for Wellsville City residents will be from **March 24 to April 21<sup>st</sup>**. Anyone wishing to burn tree limbs, branches, garden clippings, and bushes may request a burn permit by contacting **Jerald Leishman at (435) 245-6677**.

#### BURN PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. No burn permits will be issued on Sunday.
2. Burn permits will not be issued if the air quality is below 500 or on yellow or red burn days.
3. Burning of household or construction waste, rubbish, cardboard, plastics, tires, hazardous chemicals, fuels, and other processed or man-made material is prohibited.
4. Burn piles are to be kept small.
5. All open burns must be 50 feet away from any building or construction.
6. Someone 18 or older must be with the fire at all times.
7. A water source must be kept nearby.
8. All fires must be out by dark.
9. If your fire extends beyond your control, immediately call the fire department at 911.

#### STORMWATER

**STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION-** Take care of your trash, trash bins, and dumpsters. Post "No littering" signs and enforce anti-litter laws. Provide a sufficient number of litter receptacles for your home or business. Clean out and cover litter receptacles frequently to prevent spillage. Keep dumpster areas clean. Recycle materials whenever possible. Use all of a product before disposing of the container. Ensure that only appropriate solid wastes are added to the solid waste container. Certain wastes such as hazardous wastes, appliances, fluorescent lamps, pesticides, etc., may not be disposed of in solid waste containers. Take special care when loading or unloading wastes to minimize losses. Inspect dumpsters and trash bins weekly for leaks and to ensure lids are on tightly. Replace any that are leaking, corroded, or otherwise deteriorating. Sweep and clean the storage area regularly and clean up spills immediately.
