WINTER PARKING

It's that time of the year when NO PARKING WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE EDGE OF THE ROAD is allowed on any city street between the hours of midnight and 8:00 a.m. All vehicles, boats, campers, trailers, construction equipment, etc. must be removed from the city right-of-ways. Citations will be issued for those who are not in compliance. This winter parking regulation takes effect from November 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024.

GREEN WASTE COLLECTION

THE BULK GREEN WASTE CONTAINER PREVIOUSLY LOCATED AT 500 NORTH 300 EAST (NORTH OF THE WELLSVILLE CITY CEMETERY) WILL NO LONGER BE PROVIDED. A SURVEY POSTCARD IS GOING TO BE MAILED TO YOUR RESIDENCE AND WE NEED YOUR FEEDBACK CONCERNING BULK GREEN WASTE. PLEASE WATCH FOR THE SURVEY CARD, FILL IT OUT, AND RETURN IT TO THE CITY OFFICE ASAP.

If you would like a curbside green waste container you can call the city office and request one to be delivered to your home. Waste Management (who handles our garbage services) charges a one-time \$25 delivery fee for each container. The monthly fee for these containers is \$10.50, and is charged year round. Curbside green waste requires a one-year commitment.

PICKLEBALL COURTS

Wellsville City is excited to announce that our new pickleball courts will soon be open to our residents. They are located on the southeast corner of 100 South 100 East. Landscaping and painting the court lines are the final steps and will be completed as soon as the weather warms up enough. Watch the City Website or our Facebook page to be notified when the pickleball courts are ready for use. Thanks to RAPZ Tax for helping provide this opportunity to our community.

STORM WATER

Please remember that sending storm water into the city sewer system is illegal and can result in the city being fined an exorbitant amount by the EPA. Pumping ground water from your basement or yard, into the city sewer system is not allowed. Please be prepared to discharge problem ground water into ditches or into your yard, as far away from other structures as possible (but not into your neighbor's yard). Thank you for your help with this matter.

GARBAGE COLLECTION ON WELLSVILLE MILE DAY

As in the past, the Wellsville Mile will be held around the block where the old elementary school was located. Wellsville Elementary is asking the residents who live along these streets (1st East, 1st South, 2nd South and Center) to have your garbage cans to the curb by 7:00 a.m. the morning of Tuesday, May 21, 2024. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter.
