**WINTER PARKING**

It's that time of the year when **NO PARKING WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE EDGE OF THE ROAD** is allowed on any city street between the hours of midnight and 8:00 a.m. All vehicles, boats, campers, trailers, construction equipment, etc. must be removed from the city right-of-ways. Citations will be issued for those who are not in compliance. This winter parking regulation takes effect from **November 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024.**

**FIRE HYDRANT ACCESS**

We are seeking your assistance in clearing the snow away from the fire hydrants on your street. It is important that the hydrants can be easily identified and accessible if needed. Thank you for your help with this matter.

**BUSINESS LICENSING**

Business licensing renewal forms are now PAST DUE. If you have received a renewal form, please return the form to the city office ASAP. **ALL BUSINESS LICENSES MUST BE RENEWED EACH YEAR!** If you are currently engaged in business here in Wellsville, but are not licensed, please contact the City Office to apply for a business license. It is a Class B Misdemeanor to operate a business without a business license.

**SNOW REMOVAL PROBLEMS**

Removing snow becomes a problem when snow is pushed from residential driveways across the streets or blown into the street by snowblowers. This creates snow piles and ice build-up on the roads which cause a washboard effect. Subsequently, the build-up and ice cause damage to the city's snow plows. Our road crew will not attempt to plow those roads where residents have piled snow in the street. As a result, the build up of snow will cause those roads to be narrow and difficult to drive on. It is a violation of City Code to push snow across the city street. We are asking you for your cooperation concerning this matter. **THANK YOU!!**

**DOG LICENSING**

ALL DOGS THAT RESIDE IN WELLSVILLE CITY LIMITS ARE REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED. LICENSING CAN BE TAKEN CARE OF BY MAIL OR AT THE CITY OFFICE (COURT WINDOW). TO LICENSE YOUR DOG YOU MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF A CURRENT RABIES SHOT AND PROOF OF NEUTERING OR SPAYING IF THAT APPLIES TO YOUR DOG. PAYMENT CAN ONLY BE ACCEPTED BY CHECK OR CASH.
