**WINTER PARKING**

**It's that time of the year when NO PARKING WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE EDGE OF THE ROAD is allowed on any city street between the hours of midnight and 8:00 a.m. All vehicles, boats, campers, trailers, construction equipment, etc. must be removed from the city right-of-ways. Citations will be issued for those who are not in compliance. This winter parking regulation takes effect from November 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024.**

**DOG LICENSING**

ALL DOGS THAT RESIDE IN WELLSVILLE CITY LIMITS ARE REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED. LICENSING CAN BE TAKEN CARE OF BY MAIL OR AT THE CITY OFFICE (COURT WINDOW). TO LICENSE YOUR DOG YOU MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF A CURRENT RABIES SHOT AND PROOF OF NEUTERING OR SPAYING IF THAT APPLIES TO YOUR DOG. PAYMENT CAN ONLY BE ACCEPTED BY CHECK OR CASH.

**REMINDER: AFTER MARCH 31<sup>ST</sup> THE FEES FOR LICENSING YOUR DOG WILL TRIPLE.**

**WINTER STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION TIPS**

Start shoveling early, the more snow you remove, the less salt and sand you'll need. Here are some do's and don'ts when shoveling or plowing snow.

DO>Pile snow in locations with the most opportunity to infiltrate into the ground. Pile snow in areas where water does not pond. Clear away any snow that may have been thrown onto the storm drains

DON'T>Do not pile snow on top of storm drains or near where bodies and wetlands. Do not pile onto rain gardens or bioretention areas.
