- Faucets at Wellsville dam have been stolen.
- Residential doors are being broken by “doorbell ditchers.”
- Traffic signs have been spray painted.
- Street address signs are being stolen.
- The pump house in Red Side Subdivision was graffitied.
- Vandals attempted to kick in the doors at the city office building.
