WATER CONSERVATION AT HOME

Wellsville City Utilities is asking all its customers who use culinary water to water their lawns to do so on designated days of the week based on your house number beginning on June 1, 2025. It's simple to do. Check your house number, even or odd?

EVEN HOUSE NUMBERS===> MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, FRIDAY

If your house number ends in an even number, such as 532, 1298, 164, etc. water only on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday.

ODD HOUSE NUMBERS===> TUESDAY, THURSDAY, SATURDAY

If your house number ends in an odd number, such as 127, 573, 1587, water only on Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday.

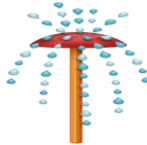
