WINTER PARKING

It's that time of year when **NO PARKING WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE EDGE OF THE ROAD IS ALLOWED ON ANY CITY STREET BETWEEN THE HOURS OF MIDNIGHT THRU 8:00 A.M.** As per Utah State Law, all vehicles, boats, campers, trailers, construction equipment, etc. must be removed from the city rights-of-way. Citations will be issued for those who are not in compliance. This winter parking regulation takes effect from **NOW THRU APRIL 30, 2026.**

BUSINESS LICENSING

As a reminder to those residents who may have a home occupation, it is time to renew your business license for 2026. If you have received a renewal form, please return the form to the city office before January 31, 2026. If you are currently engaged in business here in Wellsville, but are not licensed with the city, please contact the Wellsville City office to apply for a business license. It is a Class B Misdemeanor to operate a business without a business license from Wellsville City.

DOG LICENSING

ALL DOGS THAT RESIDE IN WELLSVILLE CITY LIMITS ARE REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED. Licensing can be taken care of by mail or at the city office (court window). To license your dog, you must provide proof of a current rabies shot and proof of neutering or spaying if that applies to your dog. Payment can only be accepted by cash or check. More information and mail renewal forms are included on the reverse side of this newsletter.

UTILITY BILLING UPDATES

As you will notice, your utility bill for January will reflect the water rate increase (Code Amendment 2024-02). This increase was approved after the public hearings held on June 5, July 3, and July 17, 2024 where the need for a new culinary well was discussed. Wellsville City conducted a Water Rate Study in May 2024 and it was determined that the current rates were inadequate to cover the costs of drilling a new well. Due to these capital needs, a 5-year water rate increase structure was adopted to cover these expenses. The monthly water rate billing amount will be as follows:

This new well, located near 900 South 200 West, was drilled to a depth of 800' and is currently flow testing at 1200 gal/min. This new well will ensure adequate water supply for all Wellsville residents, in addition to correcting serious water pressure issues on the south end of Wellsville. A pump house and other infrastructure upgrades are yet to be completed but are also a part of this project. Copies of the Water Rate Study are available at the city office for review.

In addition, **Waste Management Services** have increased their billing fees approximately 5% for garbage collection as well. The 2026 fee schedule will appear next month on your billing statement.

Please note: If you have your utility payment set up on autopay or through your bank, you will need to adjust your payment to reflect the correct payment amount.

ILLEGAL STORM WATER PUMPING

As the weather starts to produce more moisture, please be aware that disposing storm water or ground water from a sump pump into the sewer system is not allowed. This includes putting sump pump discharge into sinks, toilets, bathtubs, or floor drains. Thank you for your help with this matter.

2026 DOG LICENSING

All dogs are required to be licensed, whether they are indoor or outdoor pets. License fees are \$5.00 for dogs that are spayed/neutered, or \$10.00 for dogs that are unaltered. (You must provide a spaying/neutering certificate to purchase the \$5.00 license). All dog owners must provide proof of a current rabies vaccination for each dog. After **MARCH 31, 2026** the fees for dog tags will triple, so don't procrastinate.

MAIL RENEWAL LICENSING

Renewal forms must reach the City Office by the deadline of

March 31, 2026

1. Fill out the renewal form provided and return. Use a separate form for each dog. (If you have three or more dogs, please come into the city office for licensing.)
2. Enclose a copy of the current rabies certificate for each dog. The vaccinations must be good through **12/31/2026** (The certificate will be returned to you.)
3. Enclose the spay-neuter certificate if applicable.
4. Enclose a check made payable to "Wellsville City Corporation" for the correct amount. **Please make a separate check for utility payments!**
5. The 2026 dog tag, certificates, and receipts will be mailed back to you within 2 weeks.

ANIMAL CONTROL

Please be aware that dogs must be under physical control at all times, whether on a leash, chain or in an enclosure. Our animal control officer is actively patrolling for dogs that are running loose, and he has been issuing citations and impounding stray dogs.
