WINTER PARKING

IT IS THAT TIME OF YEAR WHEN PARKING WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE EDGE OF THE ROAD IS PROHIBITED ON ANY CITY STREET BETWEEN THE HOURS OF MIDNIGHT AND 8:00 A.M. All vehicles, boats, campers, trailers, construction equipment, etc. must be removed from the city right-of-way. Citations will be issued for those who are not in compliance. This winter parking regulation takes effect from NOVEMBER 1, 2025 TO APRIL 30, 2026.

DOG LICENSING

ALL DOGS that reside in Wellsville City limits are REQUIRED to be licensed. Licensing can be taken care of by mail or at the city office (Court Window). To license your dog, you must provide proof of current rabies shot and proof of neutering/spaying if that applies to your dog. Payment can only be accepted by Check or Cash. **REMINDER: AFTER MARCH 31ST THE FEES \$\$\$ FOR LICENSING YOUR DOG WILL TRIPLE!**

WINTER STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION TIPS

Start shoveling early, the more snow you remove, the less salt and sand you'll need. Here are some do's and don'ts when shoveling or plowing snow:

DO → Pile snow in locations with the most opportunity to infiltrate into the ground. Pile snow in areas where water does not pond. Clear away any snow that may have been thrown onto the storm drains.

DON'T → Do Not pile snow on top of storm drains or near water bodies and wetlands, onto rain gardens or bioretention areas.

TAILS SAFETY REMINDER

The trails and sidewalks in Wellsville City are for non-motorized use. If the bike you are riding does not have peddles it is not an E-bicycle and is NOT PERMITTED in these areas. These vehicles are in fact a form of motorcycle, and will be treated as such under the law, and will be considered as trespassing. As with any bike, a bell or warning system is recommended to protect others and yourself when approaching other users and blind spots. Parents, please remind your kids these rules are for everyone's safety.

ADOPT-A-PARK

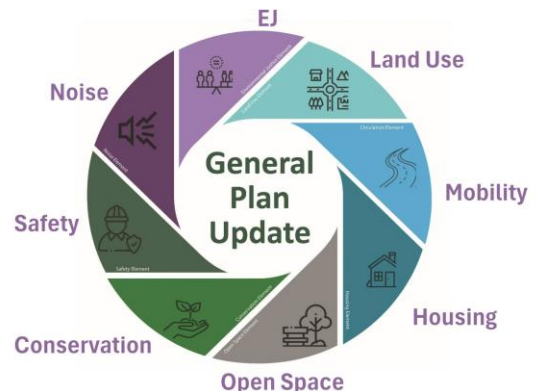
