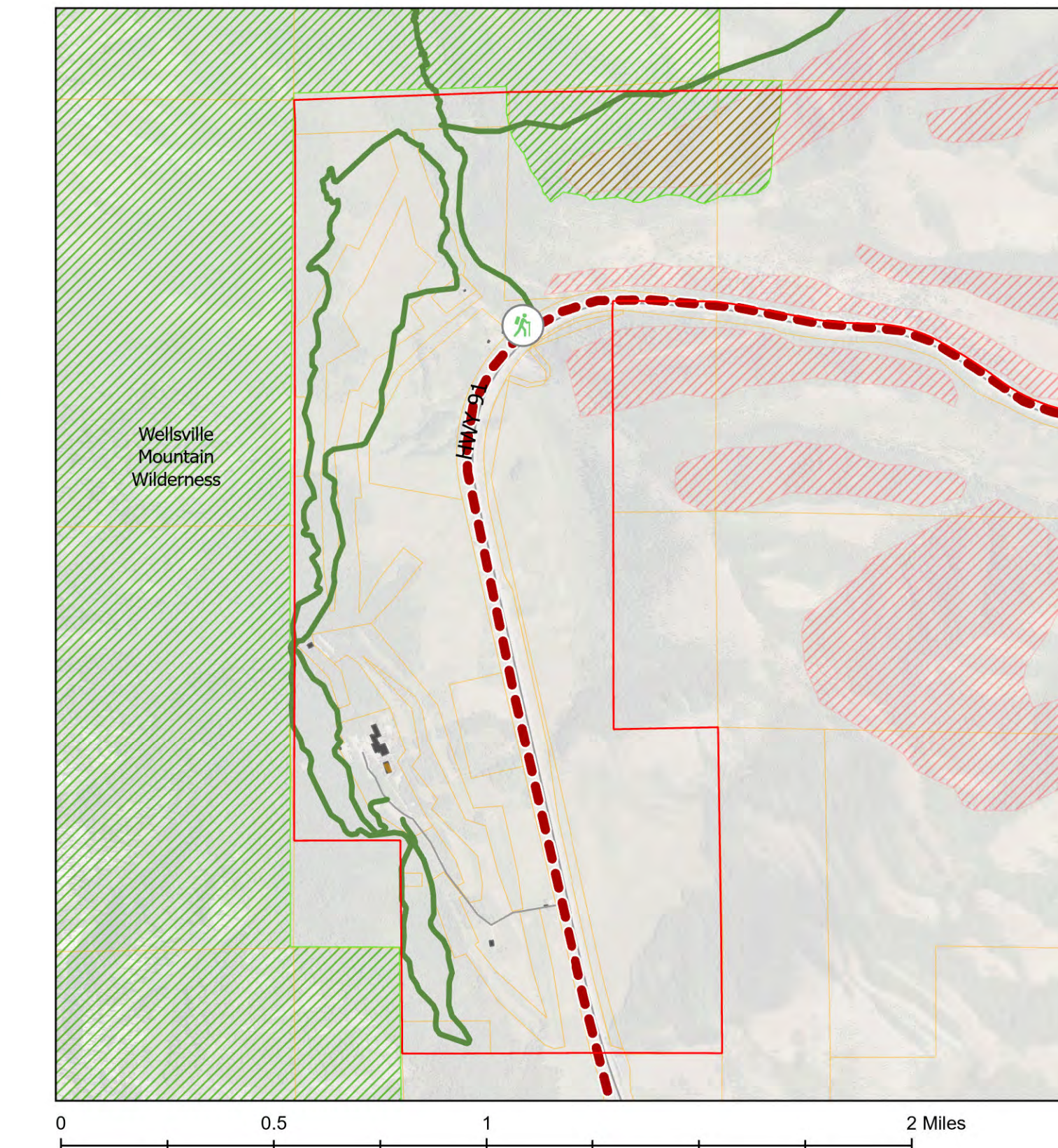

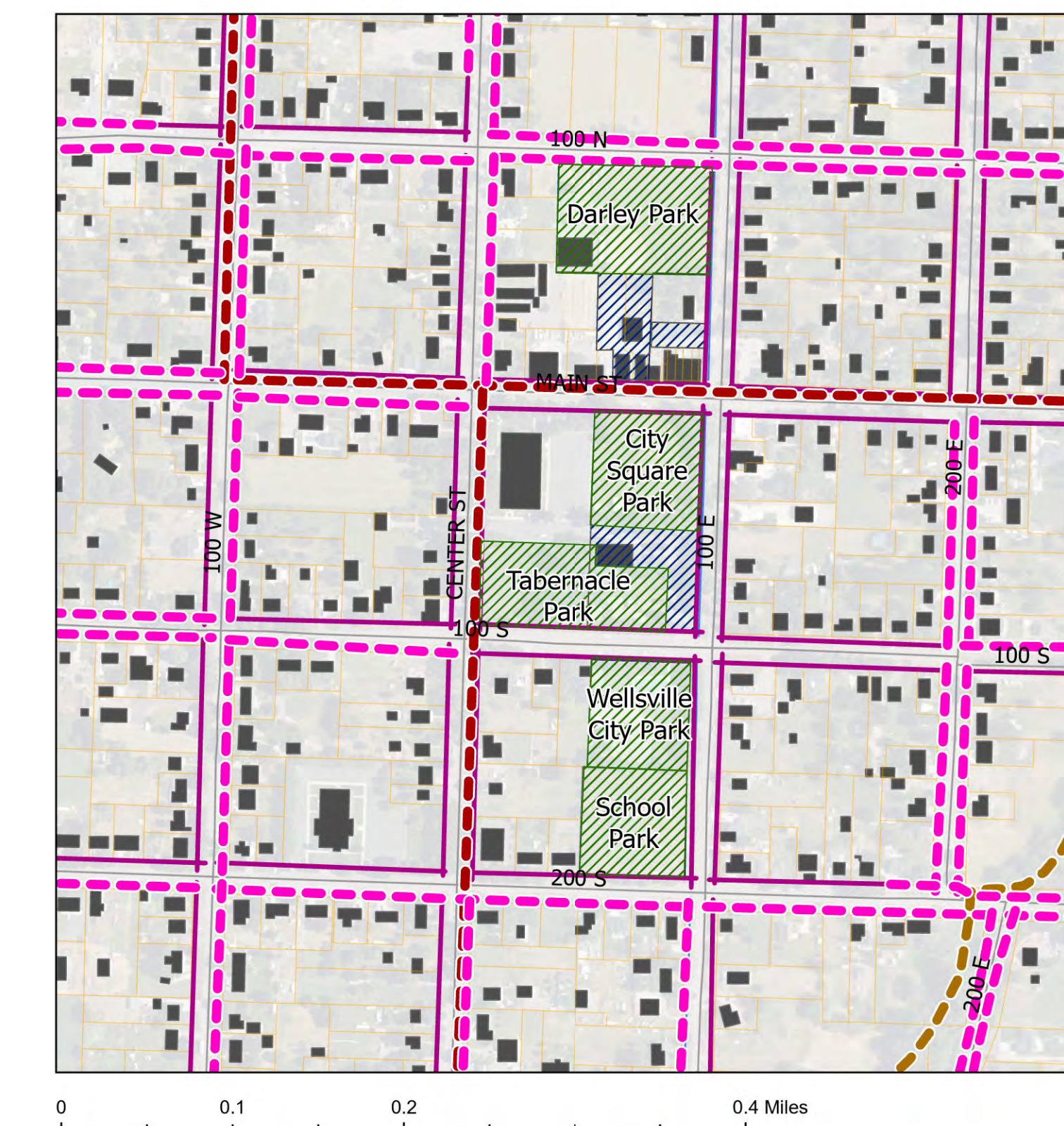

Town Square

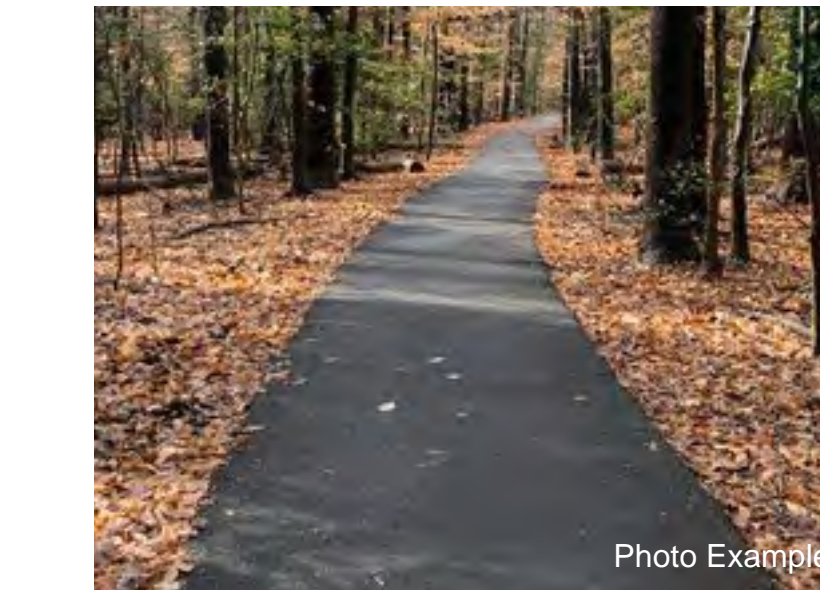


Natural Surface Trail



Gravel or soil trail used for mountain biking, hiking, walking and other outdoor activities. May be on public lands or private land with approval and easements.

Paved Pathway



Paved surface typically composed of asphalt or concrete width may vary from 8 to 12 feet wide.

Trailhead



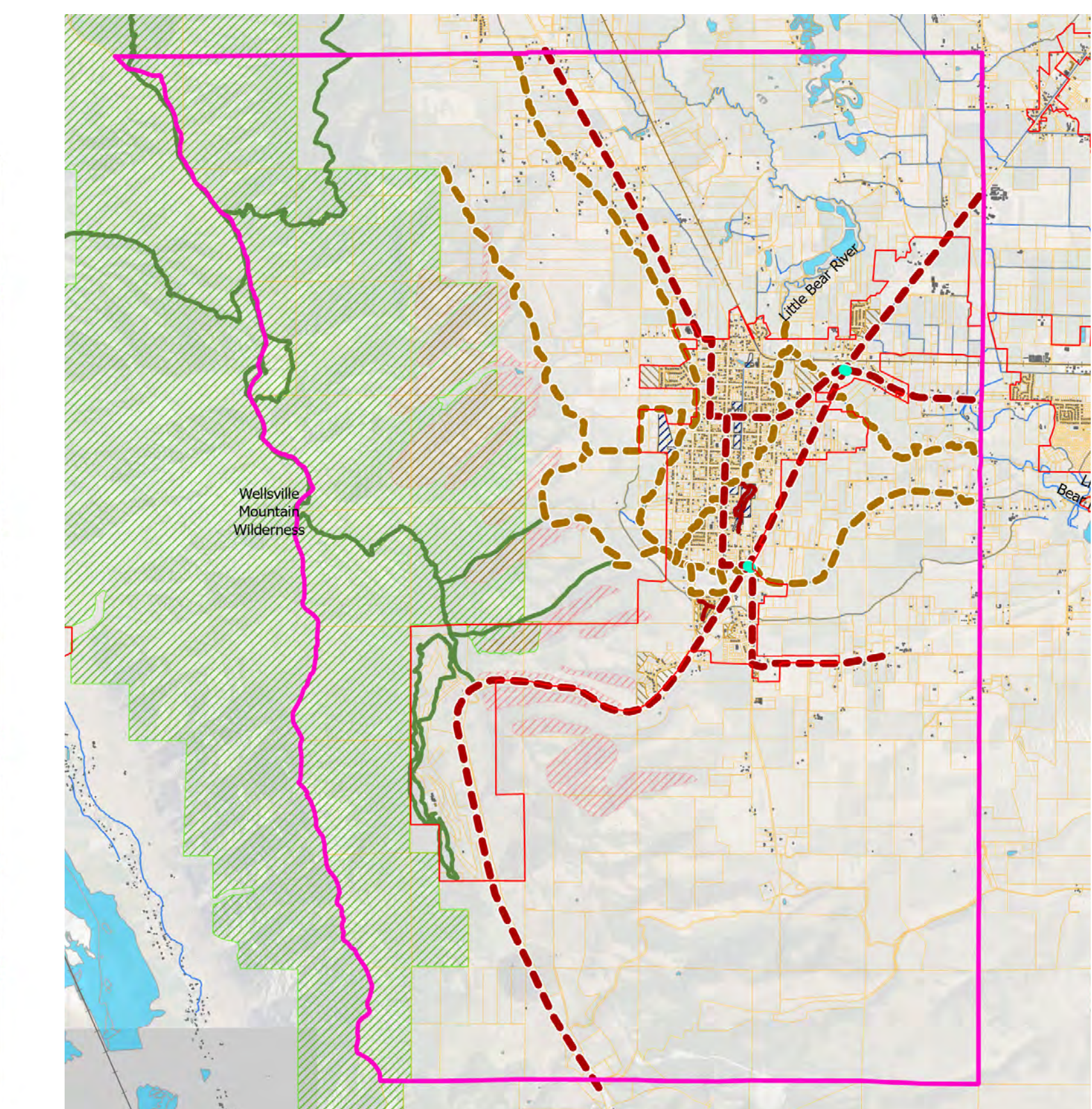
Designated start for trail. Typically includes signage and parking when feasible.

Enhanced Ped/Bike Crossing



A pedestrian crossing that uses a bridge or underpass to separate people from vehicle traffic. These crossings improve safety and comfort by allowing pedestrians, cyclists, and other non-motorized users to cross busy roads without interacting with vehicles.
