WE NEED YOUR HELP CONSERVING WATER

Wellsville City is asking all its customers who use culinary water to water their lawns to do so on designated days of the week based on your house number beginning on June 1, 2026. It's simple to do. Check your house number, even or odd?

EVEN HOUSE NUMBERS====> MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, FRIDAY

If your house number ends in an even number, such as 532, 1298, 164, etc. water only on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Yes, this means watering at night!

ODD HOUSE NUMBERS====> TUESDAY, THURSDAY, SATURDAY

If your house number ends in an odd number, such as 127, 573, 1587, water only on Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Yes, this means watering at night!

WHAT ABOUT SUNDAY? We all take a break by not watering on Sunday, but our yards will still receive enough water to keep them healthy and attractive.

Typically, even in dry and hot conditions, it is not necessary to water every day. *Thank you for your cooperation in helping to conserve our water.*

We issue Business Solicitation Badges after thorough background checks have been conducted and we can confirm that the company is legitimate. This badge will have the Wellsville City logo on it as well as a picture of the actual salesman. Do not let anyone into your home without verifying they have legal business and solicitation permits! This is for your safety!

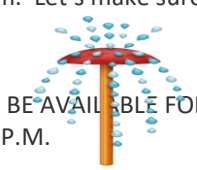


CACHE COMMUNICATIONS CENTER FEE INCREASE

Beginning July 1, 2026 the CCC Fee on the city utility bill will increase from \$3 to \$5, with a 3% increase each year thereafter. This fee is for the EMS call center, or 911 services.
