WATER CONSERVATION AT HOME

Wellsville City Utilities is asking all its customers who use culinary water to water their lawns to do so on designated days of the week based on your house number. It's simple to do. Check your house number, even or odd?

EVEN HOUSE NUMBERS===→ MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, FRIDAY

If your house number ends in an even number, such as 532, 1298, 164, etc. water only on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday.

ODD HOUSE NUMBERS===→ TUESDAY, THURSDAY, SATURDAY

If your house number ends in an odd number, such as 127, 573, 1587, water only on Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday.

WHAT ABOUT SUNDAY? We all take a break by not watering on Sunday, but our yards will still receive enough water to keep them healthy and attractive. Typically, even in dry and hot conditions, it is not necessary to water every day. ***Thank you for your cooperation in helping to conserve our water.***

SWIMMING POOL & HOT TUB WATER DISPOSAL

Water from swimming pools and hot tubs contains high levels of chlorine, bromine, algaecides, and other chemicals that can harm the environment when discharged improperly. Water treated with these chemicals can contaminate groundwater and affect plant growth and also enter storm drains that flow to surface waters (rivers, lakes, streams, etc.) where it can harm aquatic life. If you need to discharge your pool or hot tub water, please contact the public works department to discuss best practices for water safety.

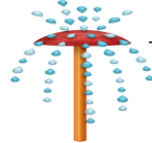
WELLSVILLE CTY COUNCIL MEMBER MID-TERM VACANCY

Notice is hereby given of a mid-term council person vacancy on the Wellsville City Council. If you are interested in serving as a council member and meet the following eligibility and residency requirements, please prepare a one-page document stating the reasons you are interested in serving on the City Council. The individual selected will fill the unexpired term of Denise N. Lindsay who has accepted the position as Wellsville City Treasurer. The term of the appointment will expire December 31, 2027. A questionnaire, available online or at the city office, expressing why you are interested in serving on the Council, must be filed at the office of the City Recorder by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 29th at 75 East Main in Wellsville, Utah.

The Council will hold a regularly scheduled council meeting on Wednesday, August 5, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. at the city offices, 75 East Main. Immediately after the routine agenda items, the council will interview each candidate then select an individual to fill the vacancy. Eligibility and Residency Requirements:

1. Candidate must be a United States Citizen at the time of filing for candidacy.
2. Must be at least 18 years of age at the time of appointment.
3. Must be a legal resident of the municipality for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of appointment.
4. Must be a registered voter on the municipality.

Pursuant to Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in the state until the right to vote or hold elective office is restored as provided by statute.

STAGE 1 FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Preventing Fire in State Lands

ALLOWED WITH CAUTION, UNDER STAGE 1 RESTRICTIONS

Campfires Allowed ONLY When:

- In an agency-developed recreation sites with pressurized water system
- OR
- In a permanently constructed fire pit at private residences with a pressurized water system

WHAT'S NOT ALLOWED

- DISCHARGING OR USING ANY FIREWORKS
- OPERATING ENGINES WITHOUT A SPARK ARRESTOR OR PARKING ON DRY GRASS
 - Chain saws
 - ATVs
 - Motorcycles
 - Other small engines
- DUMPING CHARCOAL, BRICKETTES OR HOT ASHES
- SMOKING IN DRY VEGETATION
 - Except inside a vehicle, building, developed recreation site, or an area free of dry vegetation.
- USE OF TRACER AMMO OR OTHER PYROTECHNIC DEVICES INCLUDING EXPLODING TARGETS
- CUTTING, WELDING, OR GRINDING METAL IN DRY VEGETATION
